Bestseller Johnson (*A Serpent's Tooth*) delivers a nail-biter with this seasonal Walt Longmire novella. On a snowy Christmas Eve, while reading *A Christmas Carol*, the Wyoming sheriff receives an unexpected visitor: a part-Japanese young woman who says she needs to see Walt's predecessor as sheriff, Lucian Connally, a WWII vet who flew in the Doolittle raid on Tokyo in 1942 and is now in a rest home. Flashback to December 24, 1988. A girl seriously injured in a traffic accident has to get to Denver fast for treatment, but a blizzard makes flying her there hazardous. Furthermore, the only plane available is an antique B-25, named *Steamboat* after the bucking bronco on Wyoming's license plate, and the only pilot who can fly *Steamboat* is Lucian. Soon, the two lawmen, their team, and the patient are aloft, fighting the weather and a host of mechanical problems.
